

Paris - Giverny - Le Temple-sur-Lot - Bordeaux

GETTING THERE


PRE-SYMPOSIUM: Those flying into Charles de Gaulle or Orly airports will need to get to the Montparnasse area of Paris, which is in the south of the city. Taxis will be approximately 40 Euros from Orly or 60 Euros from Charles de Gaulle. Alternatively, there are buses and trains that run from each airport to the city center. These cost around 10 Euros. The RER B commuter rail serves both airports. Tickets are purchased from machines just before the entrance to the platform. The closest and most convenient stop to the Montparnasse area is the Denfert-Rochereau station. From there transfer to the line 4 Metro. Get off at the Montparnasse stop, or take a short cab ride to the hotel. Airport shuttles also stop at Denfert-Rochereau. Those arriving by train at any one of Paris' five main stations can get to the Montparnasse area using the Metro or via taxi. MAIN SYMPOSIUM: On August 23rd pre-symposium attendees will take the 8:52 AM high-speed train from Montparnasse to Agen with arrival at 12:08 PM. There is also a train at 9:52 AM that gets into Agen in time to make the Symposium shuttle bus connections. Shuttle buses will run from Agen to Le Temple-sur-Lot between 12 PM and 3 PM. Those arriving after 3 PM will have to take a taxi to Le Temple-sur-Lot, which can cost up to 100 Euros. Those not attending the pre-symposium can get to Agen by train immediately following their flight to Paris by following the airport transfer instructions given for the pre-symposium. Alternatively, the Lot-et-Garonne area is served by four airports: Bordeaux, Toulouse, Bergerac and Agen. Bordeaux and Toulouse have bus-then-train connections to Agen. Bergerac has no direct train connection to Agen, so this option is workable only for those who intend to rent a car. There are flights from Orly airport Paris to the Agen airport, where a short taxi transfer to the train station is possible. **Driving instructions:** From Bordeaux take Exit 6 (Aiguillon) off the autoroute A62. After the toll follow the D8 at the roundabout, direction VILLENEUVE-SUR-LOT. Continue on the D8 until you cross a large bridge over the Garonne river (less than 10 minutes). Go left immediately

after the bridge, onto the D642. Follow this road until it ends in a T junction (less than 5 minutes). Go left at the junction, and then take an almost immediate right turn onto the D666, towards VILLENEUVE-SUR-LOT. This road will turn into the D911 and take you directly into the centre of Le Temple-sur-Lot after about 20 minutes. The Centre Omnisports is located just in front of the Commanderie in the center of the village (see the maps at left). From Périgueux or Bergerac, take the N21 into Villeneuve-sur-Lot. Those coming from Sarlat should get to Fumel, where the D911 brings you into Villeneuve-sur-Lot. Once in Villeneuve, follow the signs for Bordeaux. This will put you on the D911, which will put you right into the center of Le Temple-sur-Lot (in about 15 minutes).

POST-SYMPOSIUM: Various informal tours and activities will be announced, all with departures from Bordeaux on August 27.
